#### ASSUMPTION

## <u>§311.293 – Intoxicating liquor</u>

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control**, the **Department of Revenue**, the **City of Ballwin**, the **City of Kansas City**, the **City of O'Fallon**, the **City of Springfield**, and the **City of St. Louis** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **City of Hale** responded to the legislation but did not provide a fiscal impact.

**Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities and counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
