ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Attorney General's Office, Department of Public Safety – Fire Safety, Missouri Department of Conservation, Missouri Department of Transportation, and Office of Administration each assume the proposal would have no direct effect on their respective organizations.

Officials from the City of Ballwin, City of Hale, City of Kansas City, City of O'Fallon, City of Springfield, and City of Saint Louis - Budget Division each assume the proposal would have no direct effect on their respective organization.

Officials from the Missouri University, Missouri State University, State Technical College of Missouri, Northwest Missouri State University, and High Point R-III School District each assume the proposal would have no direct effect on their respective organization.

Oversight notes that the organizations have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary and assumes this is current practice. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
