#### **ASSUMPTION**

§191.240 – Provisions relating to pelvic exams

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance (DCI)** state this bill is anticipated to have no fiscal impact to the department. However, should the extent of the work be more than anticipated, the DCI would request additional appropriation and/or FTE through the budget process.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Hermann Area Hospital District** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other hospitals were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
