#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** and the **Department of Health and Senior Services** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

In response to similar proposals this year regarding county health orders, officials from the **Columbia/Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS)** stated there will be an unknown cost due to an increase in COVID-19 cases requiring disease investigation and contact tracing. It is impossible to estimate how many additional COVID-19 cases there will be because DPHHS doesn't know how many people will ignore social distancing recommendations in church.

In response to similar proposals this year regarding county health orders, officials from the **City of Corder** stated this will have a fiscal impact on their city as the largest gathering places in their community are their houses of worship. This could significantly impact their community's ability to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

In response to similar proposals this year regarding county health orders, officials from the **City** of **Gordonville** and the **City** of **Hale** stated this will have a fiscal impact on their cities, but did not provide additional information.

**Oversight** notes officials from the City of Corder, the City of Gordonville, and the City of Hale did not respond to our request for additional information regarding the potential fiscal impact of this proposal on their organizations.

**Oversight** notes it is currently the responsibility of local public health agencies (LPHAs) to conduct disease investigation and contact tracing regardless of whether a statewide emergency has been proclaimed by the governor. Oversight assumes that any potential costs that may be incurred as a result of this proposal would be <u>indirect</u> costs. Therefore, Oversight will present no fiscal impact for provisions of this proposal.
