ASSUMPTION

§27.010 – Residency Requirements for the Attorney General’s Office

In response to similar legislation from this year (HCS for HB 339), officials from the **Attorney General’s Office**, the **Office of the Secretary of State**, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **State Tax Commission** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

§285.043 – Residency Requirements for Employees

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Kansas City Board of Elections (KBEC)** assumed the financial impact would be minimal. There are potential benefits from this proposal which would include a higher quality work product and a greater selection of people to draw from.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary and will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for KBEC.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **City of Brentwood**, the **City of O’Fallon**, the **City of Southwest City**, **St. Louis City**, the **City of Tipton**, the **Crestwood Police Department**, the **Lake St. Louis Police Department**, the **Springfield Police Department**, the **Tipton Police Department**, the **Fruitland Area Fire Protection District**, the **Nodaway County Ambulance District**, the **High Point R-III School District** and the **Northwest Missouri State University** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Technical College of Missouri and the **St. Charles Community College** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, counties, local election authorities, sheriff and police departments, fire protection districts, ambulance districts, school districts, hospitals, and colleges were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.

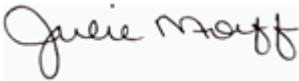
This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
