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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Attorney General's Office, the Department of Economic Development, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Higher Education, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Public Safety (Capitol Police, Alcohol & Tobacco Control, Fire Safety, Gaming Commission, Missouri Highway Patrol, Missouri National Guard, State Emergency Management Agency), the Department of Social Services, the Oversight Division, the Legislative Research Division, the Missouri Lottery Commission, the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, the Missouri Ethics Commission, the Missouri House of Representatives, the Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of Administration, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Office of the Secretary of State, the Office of the State Public Defender, the Office of the State Treasurer, the State Tax Commission, the cities: Corder, Kansas City and the St. Louis Budget Division and Northwest Missouri State University each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations for this proposal.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Officials from the **University of Missouri (MU)** state this bill will have a financial impact exceeding \$100,000 on the University of Missouri. The exact amount is difficult to quantify due to several impacts from the bill.

Oversight assumes MU is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes MU could absorb the costs related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, MU could request funding through the appropriation process.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, counties, schools, colleges and universities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
