### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the Office of Administration, Division of Facilities Management, Design and Construction (OA) state they do not make public the appraisal values for property that may be sold or conveyed because public knowledge of such information may hinder the State's ability to gain the best value for the property. Additionally, since the terms of conveyances are yet to be determined, the fiscal impact, if any, cannot be calculated. Therefore, the fiscal impact is \$0 to unknown.

Officials the Attorney General's Office and the Missouri Department of Transportation each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

**Oversight** notes this proposal conveys a parcel of property of land from the state to the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) for \$1 or less. Oversight assumes the fiscal impacts of this transaction to OA and MoDOT are <u>not material</u> and therefore we will not reflect a fiscal impact from this conveyance.
