FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** assume this legislation could create new staff duties for MoDOT staff. MoDOT does not have clear chain of title for many highways in the State Highway System. These highways typically date from long before local governments and the Department had standardized procedures for transferring road ownership.

If this legislation were to pass, the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission and MoDOT could be required to expend additional sums to acquire formal title to its right of way, despite having controlled it for decades.

Oversight assumes MoDOT is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes MoDOT could absorb the costs related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, MoDOT could request funding through the appropriation process. Therefore, Oversight will assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the State Tax Commission, the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Natural Resources and the Department of Public Safety each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the Crawford County 911 Board, the Nodaway County Ambulance District and the Hermann Area Hospital District each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.
