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# **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

§188.209 – Prohibits expenditures of public funds for research projects involving abortion, human cloning and prohibited human research

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** assume any additional litigation costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing personnel and resources. However, the AGO may seek additional appropriations if there is a significant increase in litigation.

**Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight assumes the AGO will be able to perform any additional duties required by this proposal with current staff and resources and will reflect no fiscal impact to the AGO for fiscal note purposes.

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Economic Development, the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Public Safety – Director's Office, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Department of Agriculture, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of Administration – Division of Budget and Planning and Commissioner's Office, the Office of the State Auditor, the Office of the State Public Defender, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the City of Corder, the City of Kansas City, the City of O'Fallon, the City of Springfield, the Hermann Area Hospital District, Missouri State University, Northwest Missouri State University, State Technical College of Missouri, the University of Central Missouri and the University of Missouri System each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the State Treasurer** did not respond to **Oversight's** request for a statement of fiscal impact.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, various county officials, hospitals, and colleges and universities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
