FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations**, **Office of the Secretary of State**, and **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules** each assume this proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that 16 CFR 436.1. (k) denotes [that] "Franchisor means any person who grants a franchise and participates in the franchise relationship. Unless otherwise stated, it includes sub franchisors. For purposes of this definition, a "sub franchisor" means a person who functions as a franchisor by engaging in both pre-sale activities and post-sale performance."

The proposal suggests that neither a franchisee nor a franchisee's employees shall be considered employees of a franchisor for any purpose unless the franchisor exercises direct and immediate control over the hiring, termination, discipline, and direction of the employees of a franchisee.

Officials from the above organizations assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.
