ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations**, **Missouri Department of Conservation**, and **Missouri Department of Transportation** each assume the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

In response to the previous version of this proposal officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assumed the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

In response to a similar proposal, SB 181, officials from the **Office of Administration** assumed the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

Officials from the University of Missouri System and University of Central Missouri both assume the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

In response to the previous version of this proposal officials from the Missouri State University, Northwest Missouri State University, and State Technical College of Missouri each assume the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

Officials from the City of Corder, City of Claycomo, City of Springfield each assume the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

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In response to a similar proposal (HB 758), officials from the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Attorney General's Office, the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Revenue and the Department of Social Services each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other state agencies, cities, counties, schools, colleges, universities, and counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
