ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations**, **Missouri Department of Conservation**, and **Missouri Department of Transportation** each assume the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

In response to the previous version of this proposal officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assumed the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

In response to a similar proposal, SB 181, officials from the **Office of Administration** assumed the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

Officials from the **University of Missouri System** and **University of Central Missouri** both assume the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

In response to the previous version of this proposal officials from the **Missouri State University**, **Northwest Missouri State University**, and **State Technical College of Missouri** each assume the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

Officials from the **City of Corder**, **City of Claycomo**, **City of Springfield** each assume the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization.

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In response to a similar proposal (HB 758), officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, the **Attorney General's Office**, the **Department of Commerce and Insurance**, the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Mental Health**, the **Department of Revenue** and the **Department of Social Services** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other state agencies, cities, counties, schools, colleges, universities, and counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


This bill does not appear to have a material direct fiscal impact.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


