FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§273.036 – Dog owner liability

Officials from the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol, the Missouri Department of Agriculture, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, and the St. Joseph Police Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight notes that violations of section 273.036 could result in fines or penalties. Oversight also notes per Article IX Section 7 of the Missouri Constitution fines and penalties collected by counties are distributed to school districts. Fine varies widely from year to year and are distributed to the school district where the violation occurred. Oversight will reflect a positive fiscal impact of \$0 to Unknown to local school districts.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other police and sheriff's departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
