Officials from the Department of Social Services, the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development, the Department of Mental Health, the Kansas City Police Department, the Newton County Health Department and the St. Joseph Police Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

In response to a previous version of this bill (HB 1276), officials from the Columbia/Boone County Public Health & Human Services, the Kansas City Health Department, the St. Louis County Department of Public Health and the St. Louis County Police Department each assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other county health departments, sheriffs, police, schools and hospitals were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
