ASSUMPTION

\$190.307 – Emergency services

Officials from the **Attorney General’s Office**, the **Department of Public Safety – (Fire Safety, Missouri Highway Patrol, and Office of the Director)**, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, the **Kansas City Police Department**, the **St. Louis County Police Department**, the **Crawford County 911 Board**, and the **Nodaway County Ambulance District** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Fruitland Area Fire Protection District** responded to the legislation but did not provide a fiscal impact.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other ambulances/EMS, counties, fire protection districts, and police and sheriff’s departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
