AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to medical marijuana, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be

known as section 191.255, to read as follows: 191.255. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no state

agency, including employees therein, shall disclose to the federal government, any federal 2

government employee, or any unauthorized third party the statewide list or any individual

information of persons who have applied for or obtained a qualifying patient identification

card, a qualifying patient cultivation identification card, or a primary caregiver

identification card, as those cards are described in Article XIV, Section 1 of the

7 Constitution of Missouri relating to the right to access medical marijuana. 8 2. Any violation of this section is a class E felony.
