AN ACT

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to tax revenues dedicated to school districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 67.480, to read as follows:

2 **67.480. 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no property tax**
3 **revenues dedicated to a school district shall be reduced or redirected by any program,**
4 **special taxing district, or political subdivision, and any calculation of payment in lieu of**
5 **taxes shall not include any tax revenues dedicated to a school district.**

6 **2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no sales tax revenues**
7 **dedicated to a school district shall be reduced or redirected by any program, special taxing**
8 **district, or political subdivision, and any calculation of economic activity taxes shall not**
9 **include any tax revenues dedicated to a school district.**

10 **3. This section shall not apply retroactively to any agreement or contract executed**
before August 28, 2021.
