# House Resolution No. 8

2       **WHEREAS**, the members of the Missouri House of Representatives enjoy a long, proud  
3 tradition of fulfilling their responsibilities to the citizens of this state while upholding the virtues  
4 represented by the "Glory of Missouri": Knowledge, Liberty, Equality, Law, Justice, Fraternity,  
5 Education, Progress, Honor, Truth, Virtue, Temperance, Enterprise, and Charity; and

6       **WHEREAS**, these virtues are engraved in the House Chamber of the State Capitol with  
7 the inscription: "All the foregoing human qualities bind into one theme, the Glory of Missouri  
8 because no people attain these virtues unless they are great"; and

10       **WHEREAS**, the "Glory of Missouri" Award was created to encourage the values held  
11 by the early leaders of Missouri and to recognize those standards as exemplified in schools and  
12 communities by this state's young people, the future of Missouri:

14       **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the members of the Missouri House  
15 of Representatives, One Hundred First General Assembly, hereby grant permission to use the  
16 House Chamber for the purpose of presenting the "Glory of Missouri" Awards to the students  
17 of Eureka High School, Lafayette High School, and Marquette High School on Monday,  
18 February 8, 2021, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

20       ***Special note:*** Participants in the aforementioned event shall conduct themselves in a manner that  
21 preserves the dignity and honor of the House of Representatives. Such persons shall behave  
22 respectfully and dress appropriately for the occasion. Food items, drinks, and smoking are  
23 prohibited on the floor of the House and lower gallery, and participants shall refrain from any  
24 conduct that diminishes the decorum of the House Chamber.

26 Access to the dais is limited to the Speaker's podium for purposes of using the microphone to  
27 speak to those assembled. Access to the staff area behind the rostrum is prohibited.

29 Group photographs; the hanging of any banners or other items on the walls, curtains, or any  
30 surface within the House Chamber; and the use of any equipment, including computers, phones,  
31 or other items on the dais and rostrum area, are also prohibited.
