### AN ACT

To repeal section 311.020, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to intoxicating liquor.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 311.020, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 311.020, to read as follows:

311.020. The term "intoxicating liquor" as used in this chapter shall mean and include alcohol for beverage purposes, alcoholic, spirituous, vinous, fermented, malt, or other liquors, or combination of liquors, a part of which is spirituous, vinous, or fermented, and all preparations or mixtures for beverage purposes, containing in excess of one-half of one percent by volume. **The term "intoxicating liquor" shall also include "powdered alcohol", which means alcohol that is prepared in a powdered, crystalline, or capsule form for direct use or for reconstitution.** All beverages having an alcoholic content of less than one-half of one percent by volume shall be exempt from the provisions of this chapter~~[-but subject to inspection as provided by sections 196.365 to 196.445].~~
