### AN ACT

To amend chapter 217, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to parole eligibility.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 217, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 217.689, to read as follows:

**217.689. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any offender sentenced under**  
2 **subsection 3 of section 195.295 shall be eligible for parole after having served ten years of**  
3 **such sentence if the board determines that there is a strong and reasonable probability that**  
4 **the offender will not thereafter violate the law.**
