AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the participation of home school students in public school activities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 167.790, to read as follows:

167.790. 1. In order to receive funds under section 163.031, no school district shall 2 be a member of, or remit any funds to, any statewide activities association that:

3 (1) Prohibits a student who is receiving instruction at a home school, as defined in 4 section 167.031, from the opportunity to participate in any event or activity offered by the 5 school district or an attendance center of the school district in which the student resides 6 and where the statewide activities association exercises authority, rules, or guidelines for 7 participating in such events or activities for any reason relating to such student's home 8 instruction; or

9 (2) Requires a student to attend more than one class directly related to, and 10 necessary for, participation in an event or activity in order to participate in such an event 11 or activity.

2. The department of elementary and secondary education shall withhold payments under section 163.031 for any district in violation of this section. The department shall release any withheld funds under this section upon the district providing satisfactory proof to the state board of education that the school district has ceased membership in the association and has ceased remission of any funds to said association.
