## AN ACT

To repeal section 33.100, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to payment of salaries out of the state treasury.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 33.100, RSMo, is repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 33.100 and 105.008, to read as follows:

33.100. The salaries of all elective and appointive officers and employees of the state

shall be paid out of the state treasury, in biweekly, semimonthly, or monthly installments as

designated by the commissioner of administration. The accounts and names of the officers and

4 employees shall be presented to the commissioner of administration and a warrant therefor upon

the state treasury shall be issued to be paid out of the appropriation made for such purpose. The

6 accounts of the officers and employees shall be stated in their names, respectively, and the

correctness thereof shall be certified to by the officers, respectively, in whose employment they

8 are.

> 105.008. Pay periods for state employees, as defined in section 105.800, shall not exceed fourteen days, except in cases where a payday falls on a holiday and requires that employees be paid before the regularly scheduled payday or as otherwise provided under

section 33.100.
