WHEREAS, municipal employees throughout this state play an important role in 2 carrying out many critical local government functions that benefit our communities and help 3 keep them safe and prosperous; and

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5 WHEREAS, municipal employees often have children, spouses, and other family 6 members in need of their care, especially during this time as the state of Missouri continues its 7 fight against the COVID-19 pandemic; and

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9 WHEREAS, many municipal employees in this state are unable to provide necessary 10 care and attention to their family members because their municipal employers do not provide 11 paid family leave as an employee benefit; and

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WHEREAS, by providing fourteen weeks of paid family leave to municipal employees, municipalities can ensure that their municipal employees, who serve our communities each day, are able to provide necessary care and attention to their family members without risking their jobs or their family's economic security:

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18 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of 19 Representatives of the One Hundred First General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate 20 concurring therein, hereby express our support for each municipality in this state to provide 21 fourteen weeks of paid family leave to its municipal employees.

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
