### **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to public school athletic contests.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 167.177, to read as follows:

167.177. 1. To ensure fair competition in interscholastic athletic contests organized by publicly funded secondary schools, it is the public policy of this state that any student who attends a publicly funded secondary school and participates in athletic contests organized by the school should participate in athletic contests organized for persons of the same biological sex included on the student's original birth certificate.

- 2. To respect transgender students and students who wish to participate in an interscholastic athletic contest organized for persons of the opposite biological sex, students may participate in athletic contests as follows:
- (1) A biologically female student may participate in an athletic contest organized for females, males, or both sexes;
- 11 (2) A biologically male student may participate in an athletic contest organized for males or both sexes;
- (3) A transgender male student who is transitioning or has transitioned from female
  to male and who has not taken hormone therapy to transition may participate in an athletic
  contest organized for females, males, or both sexes;

16 **(4)** A transgender male student who is transitioning or has transitioned from female 17 to male and who has taken hormone therapy to transition may participate in an athletic 18 contest organized for males or both sexes; and

- (5) A transgender female student who is transitioning or has transitioned from male to female may participate in an athletic contest organized for males or both sexes regardless of hormone-therapy use.
- 3. Any participation in athletic contests not described in subsection 2 of this sectionis prohibited.
