AN ACT

To amend chapter 311, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to Kansas City whiskey.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 311, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 311.027, to read as follows:

311.027. To qualify as "Kansas City Whiskey", and to be labeled as such, a product shall be a spirit that meets the following conditions:

(1) The product shall be produced and bottled within the state of Missouri;

(2) The product shall be bottled at no less than forty percent alcohol by volume;

(3) The product shall consist of a blend of straight, light, or any other type of whiskey, excluding neutral spirits or unaged grain spirits; provided that, all whiskey used in such a blend shall have an age of at least two years;

(4) The product shall be blended with sherry, as a flavoring agent; provided that, the sherry is imported from the Jerez de la Frontera region of Spain and the amount of the sherry does not exceed two and one-half percent by volume as measured in proof gallons; and

(5) The product shall not include any additional coloring, flavoring, or blending materials.
