### **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 542, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to searches of private property.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 542, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 542.525, to read as follows:

542.525. 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law, no employee of a state agency or a political subdivision of the state shall:

- 3 (1) Enter private property, regardless of whether the property is considered the 4 home or curtilage, without probable cause, permission of the property owner, or a valid 5 search warrant; or
- 6 (2) Place any surveillance camera or game camera on private property without the 7 knowledge of the property owner.
- 8 2. The provisions of this section shall not apply in cases involving national security 9 or missing persons or investigations of felony offenses by law enforcement.
