AN ACT

To amend chapter 590, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to arrest notifications.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 590, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 590.1275, to read as follows:

590.1275. 1. If any person is arrested for a misdemeanor or felony offense, the law enforcement agency making the arrest shall, within twenty-four hours of such arrest, notify the arrested person's parent or legal guardian if he or she is under eighteen years of age or, if the arrested person is eighteen years of age or older, notify the person's designated contact.

6 2. For purposes of this section, "designated contact" means an individual identified
7 by the arrested person for the limited purpose of arrest notification under this section. A
8 designated contact shall be eighteen years of age or older.
