AN ACT

To repeal section 210.542, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to cardiopulmonary resuscitation training for foster parents.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 210.542, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 210.542, to read as follows:

210.542. 1. The children's division shall provide certain standards and training that prospective foster care parents shall meet before becoming licensed.

2. The children's division shall provide performance-based criteria for the evaluation of licensed foster parents and may establish by rule the frequency of such evaluation.

3. **Any person who has received certification in the administration of cardiopulmonary resuscitation as part of his or her professional or occupational training may substitute such certification for any cardiopulmonary resuscitation training required of him or her to obtain a license to become a foster parent.**
