AN ACT

To amend chapter 1, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to fees for business licenses.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 1, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be

known as section 1.600, to read as follows: 1.600. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, if a business is closed for at least

- sixty days solely due to a shutdown order, any fee for a business license shall be waived for 2
- the business during the period of the shutdown order or six months, whichever is more.
- Fees for a business license may be prorated. As used in this section, "shutdown order"
- means any order by the state, or an agency or political subdivision thereof, to close a
- business during a state of emergency declared by the governor that is caused by any reason
- outside the business's control. This section shall not be construed to apply to a license or
- certification of an individual to practice a profession. The state shall reimburse political
- subdivisions for revenues lost due to this section.
