AN ACT

To repeal section 227.803, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the designation of a memorial highway.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 227.803, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 227.803, to read as follows:

227.803. The portion of State Highway 7 from County Road 221 West continuing to ~~Calvin Drive~~ **State Highway 52** in the city of Clinton in Henry County shall be designated as "Police Officer Christopher Ryan Morton Memorial Highway". The department shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway with the costs to be paid for by private donations.
