HB 92 -- AUTOCYCLES

SPONSOR: Taylor (139)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 14 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill removes from the definition of "autocycle" the provision that it is designed to be controlled with a steering wheel and pedals.

This bill is the same as HB 1641 (2020).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that a new type of autocycle has handlebars instead of a steering wheel, so the Department of Revenue will not register it.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Taylor; Arnie Dienoff; Joe Widmer; and Abate For Missouri.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
