

HB 100 -- SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES

SPONSOR: Sharp (36)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 13 to 0. Voted "Do Pass-Consent" by the Standing Committee on Consent and House Procedure by a vote of 9 to 0.

This bill allows for the issuance of a "Negro Leagues Baseball Museum" specialty license plate upon making a \$10 contribution to the Negro Leagues Baseball Museum, and a \$15 fee in addition to the regular registration fee.

This bill is similar to HB 2690 (2020).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the museum is a great asset to the state of Missouri and the specialty license plate will help to advertise and promote it.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Sharp; Bobby Kendrick; and Casey Klapmeyer.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill say that, while they support the cause, Missouri does not need so many different license plates.

Testifying against the bill was Arnie Dienoff.
