

HB 164 -- SCHOOL DISTRICT SUBDISTRICTS

SPONSOR: Veit

This bill allows for any seven-director school district or an urban district to be divided into subdistricts and provides for the process for the election of subdistrict board members.

Subdistricts shall be of contiguous and compact territory and as nearly equal in population as practicable. The length of directors terms, election procedures, filling of vacancies, and residency requirements are detailed in the bill.

This bill is similar to HB 2029 (2020).
