HB 294 -- TRAFFIC OFFENSES

SPONSOR: Roberts (161)

This bill repeals certain provisions that authorize arrest warrants for failure to respond, pay the assessed fine, or appear in court with respect to a traffic citation issued for an infraction under Chapter 304, RSMo, and instead authorizes a court to issue a notice of failure to respond, pay the assessed fine, or appear. No driver's license or driver's license renewal shall be issued if the applicant has delinquent fines and fees in connection with the traffic offense that have not been satisfied.

The bill also lowers the penalty for certain traffic offenses as specified in the bill.

This bill is the same as HB 1546 (2020).
