HB 347 -- UNIFORM INTERSTATE DEPOSITIONS

SPONSOR: Veit

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Litigation Reform by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules-Legislative Oversight by a vote of 11 to 0.

This bill creates the "Uniform Interstate Depositions and Discovery Act" and provides procedures and processes for when a subpoena for discovery or deposition is submitted in Missouri by a foreign jurisdiction, which is defined in this bill as a state other than Missouri.

This bill is similar to HB 2570 (2020).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that majority of the country has already enacted this bill. Missouri will become compliant with current procedures with the bill.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Veit; Arnie Dienoff; Kaitlin Wolff, Uniform Law Commission; and Uniform Law Commission.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
