HB 377 -- STUDENTS VOTING

SPONSOR: Gunby

The bill allows any student who is eligible to vote to absent himself or herself from school for a period of up to three hours between the opening and closing times of the polls to vote. The student must provide proof of voting. The school may specify when a student can vote and any school violating this requirement will be guilty of a class four election offense.

This bill is the same as HB 2623 (2020).
