HB 445 -- SPECIAL ROAD DISTRICTS

SPONSOR: McGirl

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Local Government by a vote of 10 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 12 to 0.

Currently, certain special road districts are restricted to expend not more than one-fourth the district's revenue within the corporate limits of any city within the district.

This bill removes the restriction.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill frees up the money to be used where most needed.

Testifying for the bill were Representative McGirl; Arnie C. Dienoff; Gary W. Boyer, Hillsboro Special Road District; Buddy Russell, Hillsboro Special Road District; and Missouri Municipal League.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
