HB 544 -- MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

SPONSOR: Deaton

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 13 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 9 to 0.

This bill designates a portion of U.S. Business 71 Highway in McDonald County as the "Army PFC Christopher Lee Marion Memorial Highway".

The costs of signs designating the highway shall be paid by private donations.

This bill is the same as HB 1976 (2020).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this is a fitting tribute to Mr. Marion.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Deaton.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill say that dedicating portions of highways and bridges only to some people who served in the military is not fair to all persons who have served in the military.

Testifying against the bill was Arnie C. Dienoff.
