HB 556 -- BALLOT NAMING

SPONSOR: Eggleston

This bill imposes a labeling requirement for political subdivision and special district ballot measures beginning with "Proposition A" and so on consecutively to "Proposition Z" and continuing with double letters in alphabetical order if necessary. If a measure is labeled, but not voted upon at the next election, then it retains its letter designation until it has been voted on. This practice is identical to the current law on statewide ballot measure labeling.
