HB 569 -- CANCER AWARENESS LICENSE PLATE

SPONSOR: Basye

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 13 to 0.

This bill allows for the issuance of a "cancer awareness" specialty license plate upon the annual payment of a \$25 contribution to support cancer awareness activities conducted by the Department of Health and Senior Services, in addition to the \$15 registration fee.

This bill is similar to HB 2271 (2020).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this license plate raises money for a good cause.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Basye; and the Missouri Poultry Federation.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill say that there are many worthy causes in our state. There are so many that it has become confusing.

Testifying against the bill was Arnie Dienoff.
