HB 605 -- MEMORIAL BRIDGE

SPONSOR: Basye

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 13 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 9 to 0.

This bill designates the bridge on U.S. Highway 63 crossing the BSNF Railroad/Marceline Sub in La Plata in the Macon County as the "U.S. Army PFC Adam L Thomas Memorial Bridge".

The costs of signs designating the highway shall be paid by private donations.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this is a fitting tribute for Mr. Thomas.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Basye.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill say that certain military persons should not be treated better than others.

Testifying against the bill was Arnie C. Dienoff.
