

HB 625 -- COMPETENCY-BASED EDUCATION TASK FORCE

SPONSOR: Richey

This bill establishes the "Competency-Based Education Task Force", with two members to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, whose mission is to study and develop competency-based education programs in public schools. The Task Force shall conduct interviews and at least three public hearings to identify promising Competency-Based Education Programs and obstacles of implementing such programs. Before December 1 of each year, the Task Force shall present its findings and recommendations to the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President Pro Tem of the Senate, the Joint Committee on Education, and the State Board of Education.

This bill is similar to SB 35 (2021).
