HB 626 -- MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

SPONSOR: Griffith

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 12 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 9 to 0.

This bill designates that portion of U.S. State Highway 54 from State Highway E to State Highway D in Cole County as the U.S. Army Specialist Michael Campbell Memorial Highway".

The cost of signs designating the highway shall be paid by private donation.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this is a fitting tribute for Mr. Campbell.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Griffith; Allen Templeton; and David Zumbehl.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill say that it is not fair that not all veterans get memorial highways.

Testifying against the bill was Arnie C. Dienoff.
