HB 731 -- CONVEYANCE OF PROPERTY

SPONSOR: Perkins

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Corrections and Public Institutions by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill authorizes the conveyance of state property in Pike County to the State Highways and Transportation Commission.

This bill is the same as SB 851 (2020).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill will make efficient use of unused Department of Transportation property and that a willing buyer has been located.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Perkins; Erin Warner, Missouri Department of Transportation; and Arnie C. Dienoff.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
