HB 747 -- PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX

SPONSOR: Toalson Reisch

This bill authorizes any city of the fourth classification with more than 1,350 but fewer than 1,500 inhabitants and located in any county of the first classification with more than 150,000 but fewer than 200,000 inhabitants to levy a sales tax of up to one-half of one percent dedicated to public safety upon voter approval.

Upon enactment this sales tax will only apply in Hallsville.

This bill is similar to HB 1731 (2020).
