HB 868 -- TOBACCO PRODUCTS

SPONSOR: Nurrenbern

This bill taxes alternative nicotine products and vapor products at 10% of the manufacturer's invoice price before discounts and deals and such tax will be paid by the person making the first sale within the state (Section 149.160, RSMo).

This bill prohibits the sale of tobacco products, alternative nicotine products, and vapor products to anyone under the age of 21 (Section 407.926 to 407.934).

This bill prohibits the sales of any tobacco, alternative nicotine, or vapor products that are flavored. Anyone who violates this provision will be fined \$250 for the first violation and \$500 for each subsequent violation (Section 407.1615).

This bill is similar to HB 2614 (2020).
