HB 881 -- LIQUOR SALES

SPONSOR: Coleman (097)

This bill provides that the holder of a valid license to sell intoxicating liquor in the manufacturer's original package may sell liquor to a consumer in a container other than the manufacturer's original package, provided that:

(1) The container is leakproof and sealable and contains a certain amount of liquor as provided in the bill;

(2) The consumer orders and purchases a meal at the same time as the consumer purchases the liquor;

(3) The holder of the license provides the consumer with a dated receipt for the purchase of the intoxicating liquor; and

(4) The sealed container is placed in a separate, one-time use transparent bag that is sealed or the opening to the sealed container has been separately sealed with tamperproof tape.

This bill is the same as SB 283 (2021).
