

HB 895 -- GUN RIGHTS FOR NONVIOLENT FELONS

SPONSOR: Davis

This bill modifies the laws regarding criminal offenses for felons possessing firearms as provided in Section 571.070, RSMo. A felon who committed a violent felony, as described in the bill, is still subject to the offenses provided in that section. A felon who committed a nonviolent felony, as described in the bill, does not commit the offense of unlawful possession if he or she has completed his or her sentence, including probation or parole term, for that nonviolent felony offense.
