HB 992 -- OFFENSE OF KEEPING A DANGEROUS DOG

SPONSOR: Burger

Currently, a person commits the offense of keeping a dangerous dog if he or she possess a dog that has previously bitten a person or domestic animal without provocation and then bites a person again. This bill changes the offense to include a dog that has previously physically injured a person or domestic animal without provocation and physically injures a person again.

This bill is the same as HCS HB 1525 (2020).
