HB 1027 -- WEAPONS OFFENSES

SPONSOR: Lovasco

Currently, individuals convicted of a felony offense in Missouri or any other state may not possess a firearm. This bill enables individuals convicted of a felony offense to possess a firearm if he or she has completed his or her sentence, including supervised release, probation, or parole. This bill also removes the restrictions on individuals "habitually in an intoxicated or drugged condition" from possessing firearms.
